We want people who are dedicated and passionate about bringing a truly unique new food offer to the Harbour and we believe this is a great opportunity for both local and regional food entrepreneurs to trade from this picturesque working harbour.

PITCH SIZE

The maximum pitch sizes are 20ft x 8ft.

The pitch includes:

- Metered 32amp power supply
- Access to a potable water tap
- Access to a Wifi network
- Supply of EPOS till and receipt printer

RENTAL & CHARGES

We charge rental as a percentage of daily turnover which is paid on a weekly basis. Electricity and EPOS license is charged on a monthly basis.

TIMELINE FOR APPLICATION PROCESS

- Deadline for submission is midday on the 6 June 2021.
- Shortlisted applicants will be notified on the 8 June 2021.
- Shortlisted applicants meetings and sample tasting during the week of the 9-16 June 2021.
- Successful applicants to be notified on the 18 June 2021.
- Trading can start from the 25 June 2021.

DOCUMENTATION REQUIRED FOR SUCCESSFUL APPLICANTS

Successful applicants will be required to sign a lease and provide the following paperwork before trading commences.

- Public, Product & Employers Liability Insurance (£10 million)
- PAT certificate for all electrical equipment
- Hygiene certificate / rating (can be once business is open)
- Level 2 Food Safety Certificate
- Covid-19 Risk Assessment
- H&S Risk Assessment
- Fire Risk Assessment
- Gas Certificate (if applicable)
- Deposit payment of £350

HOW TO APPLY

Please provide the following information:

- A short proposal of what you want to do which includes a clear description of what food you want to offer.
- Tell us why you think you and your business is a good fit for Folkestone Harbour.
- Your proposed menu.
- Indication of the food suppliers you intend to work with.
- An interior and exterior picture of your mobile unit.
- A name for your business.
- Details about your previous experience.

If we like the look of your written proposal, we'll ask to meet you, sample what you propose to offer and talk further about your proposal.

If you are not successful this time round, but we like what you do, we will keep you in mind when new opportunities arise such as food festivals and market days, or when new spaces become available in the future.
